

Document checklist for UK Student Visa

Basic Documents

- 1. Duly filled online visa application.
- 2. Current passport.
- 3. Previous passport with previous visa and stamps [If applicable].
- 4. National ID card or Birth Certificate.
- 5. Letter of explanation or cover letter detailing your identity, purpose of application, Purpose of study, Future plan, fund arrangement, accommodation, and ties with Bangladesh etc.

CAS and relevant documents

- 1. Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS).
- 2. All academic certificates and mark sheets submitted to obtain the CAS.
- 3. English proficiency certificate (IELTS, UKVI, etc.) and/or Medium of Instruction (MOI) certificate used to obtain the CAS.
- 4. Employment letter from the employer confirming employment details, including joining date, position, responsibilities, salary, etc. [If applicable].

Medical Report and Immigration Health Surcharge (IHS)

- 1. Tuberculosis (TB) Test Report. The Tuberculosis (TB) test for UK visa applicants in Bangladesh is conducted by the International Organization for Migration (IOM). The price for the test is around BDT. 7,000.00.
- 2. Immigration Health Surcharge (IHS) is mandatory for students from Bangladesh. The fee is GBP 470 per year, which must be paid before applying for the student visa and is refundable in case of visa refusal.

Fund arrangement

- 1. A savings account statement for the applicant covering the last 28 days, showing sufficient funds to cover tuition fees and living costs for the first 9 months, held in the account throughout this period.
- 2. If your parent is funding your education, a financial sponsorship declaration is required, along with the account statement(s) of your parent(s).

Other documents

- 1. A Statement of Purpose for the intended course of study at the UK University.
- 2. Curriculum Vitae [If applicable].
