

Document checklist for Family Reunification Visa Application to join a family member in Canada

Basic Documents

- 1. Duly filled online visa application [IRCC].
- 2. Duly filled IMM 1344 [the sponsor].
- 3. Duly filled IMM 5406 [the applicant and sponsor].
- 4. Duly filled IMM 5540 [the sponsor].
- 5. Duly filled IMM 0008 [the applicant].
- 6. Duly filled IMM 1283 [the applicant and sponsor].
- 7. Duly filled IMM 5481 [the sponsor]
- 8. Current passport.
- 9. Previous passport with previous visa and stamps.
- 10. National ID card / Birth Certificate.
- 11. Photo [35x450] mm with an off-white background.

Proof of Relationship with the Sponsor

- 1. Marriage Certificate [if applicable].
- 2. Birth Certificate [if applicable].
- 3. Family Photograph [if applicable].

Police Clearance of the Applicant

1. If the applicant has lived in any country or countries for more than six months in the last ten years, a police clearance certificate from that country is required.

Declaration and Sponsorship Undertaking

1. The sponsor must sign an **undertaking** to financially support the applicant(s) for a specific period, which can range from 3 to 20 years depending on the applicant's age and relationship type.

Evidence of Immigration Status of Sponsor in Canada

 Evidence of the sponsor's Canadian citizenship or legal permanent residency, such as a Canadian passport, birth certificate, citizenship certificate, permanent resident card, or Record of Landing (IMM 1000), confirming the sponsor's current status in Canada.

Proof of Accommodation

1. Evidence that the applicant will have a place to stay upon arrival in Canada (e.g., a rental agreement, proof of ownership, or a letter from the sponsor confirming accommodation arrangements).

Evidence of Financial Capability of the Sponsor

2. Proof of income (such as tax returns, pay slips, and bank statements) to demonstrate that the sponsor can support the applicant. Although there is no strict income requirement for a spouse and/or dependent children, sponsors must show the ability to provide for their family members' basic needs. The sponsor must have an annual income of approximately CAD 61,000 to sponsor a spouse and a parent(s) or grandparent(s).

Medical Examination Report

The applicant must undergo a medical examination performed by an approved physician authorized by IRCC.
